Applications are being accepted for children who will be 3 years old for half-day Head Start or 4 years old on/or before September 1, 2010, for all day Head Start/Pre-kindergarten.

The Port Arthur Independent School District (PAISD) Head Start Program will enroll 388 students for the 2010-2011 school year. At least 10% of the enrollment opportunities must be made available to children with disabilities.

The PAISD Head Start Program will serve children with disabilities. According to Head Start Performance Standards (1308.3) the term "children with disabilities" means children with mental retardation, hearing impairments including deafness, speech and language impairments, visual impairments including blindness, serious emotional disturbance, orthopedic impairments, autism, traumatic brain injury, other health impairments or specific learning disabilities, and whom, by reason thereof, need special education and related services.
